The first phase of the Worthing Heat Network, connecting six key buildings across the town, is now complete. Works have now commenced on the next phase, which will complete the main spine of the network by linking two of Worthing's best-known landmarks: Splashpoint Leisure Centre and the Pavilion Theatre.

Shaped by local feedback, the works are being planned with the community in mind, using underground tunnelling along much of the pipe route to reduce disruption, keep businesses open, and maintain access to the seafront. Construction has been carefully timed to avoid disruption during key periods in the town's calendar.

PIT LOCATION 2

STEYNE GARDENS



(February - June)



To install the underground pipework, a small excavation in Steyne Gardens will be carried out, with a wider works area safely enclosed with temporary fencing. The construction area will also include pipe reels and drilling equipment as part of the works.

A traffic management plan will be in place to maintain safe pedestrian access at all times. These works are taking place within the gardens, so motorists will not be affected. Our team is specially trained to protect ecological and heritage features throughout the works.

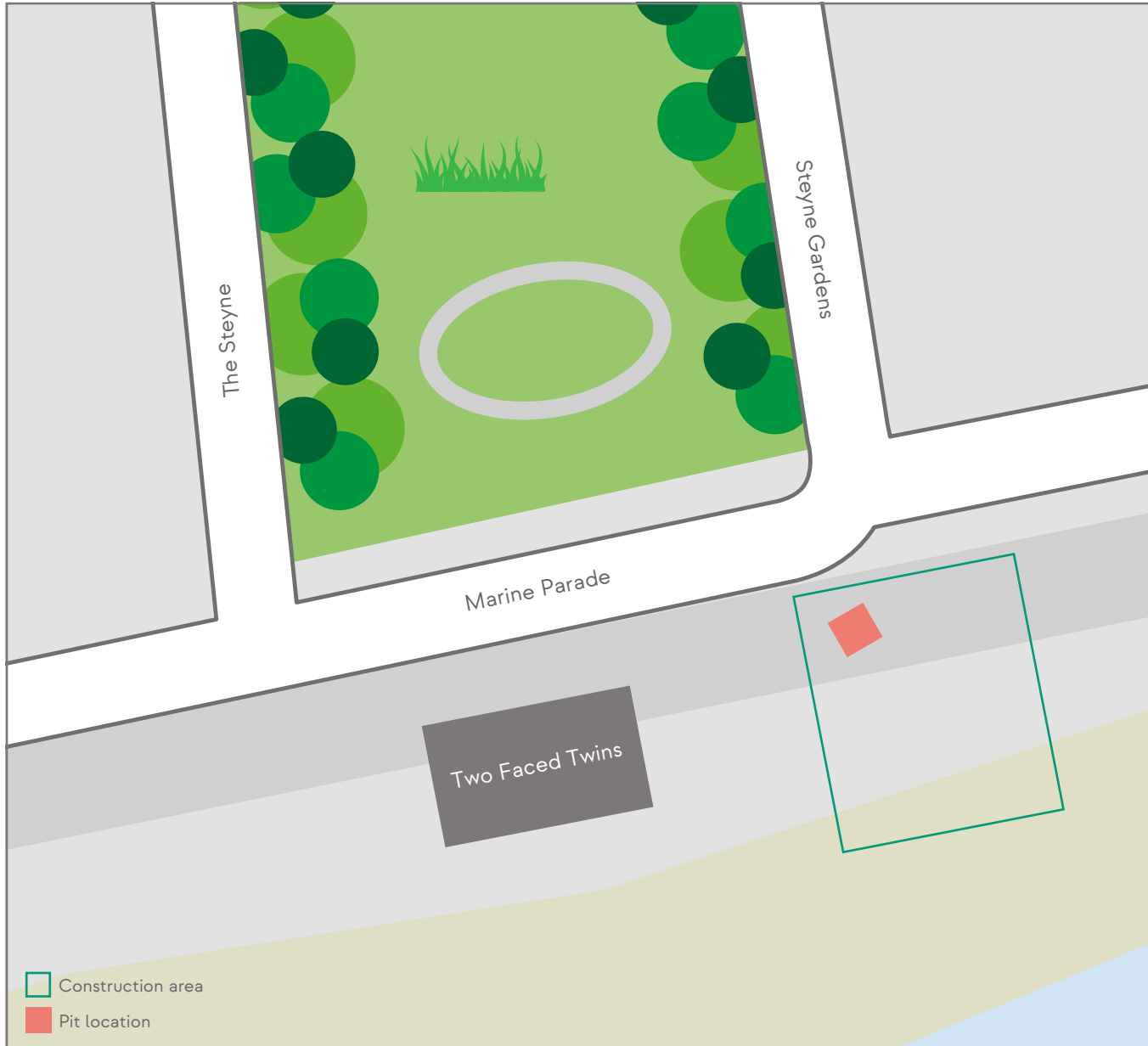

PIT LOCATION 3

PROMENADE SOUTH OF STEYNE GARDENS

(March - April)



To install the underground pipework, a small excavation on the Promenade will be carried out and safely enclosed with temporary fencing. The construction area will also include pipe reels and drilling equipment as part of the works.

A traffic management plan will be in place to maintain safe pedestrian access. This could include minor diversions or marshalled traffic where required. These works are taking place on the footpath, so motorists will not be affected.



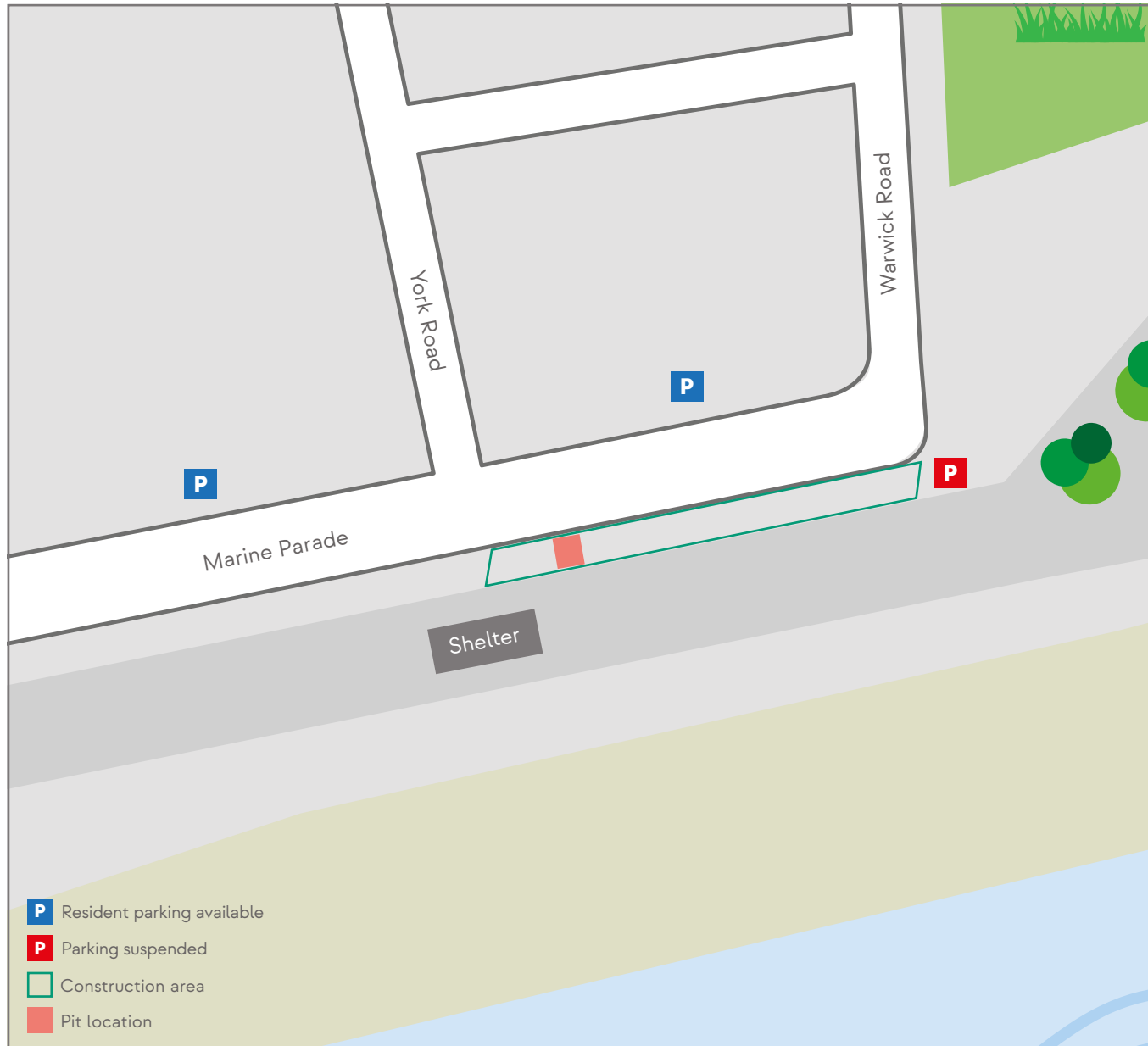
Legend:

PIT LOCATION 4

MARINE PARADE EAST

(March - April)



To facilitate underground installation of pipe, a small excavation will be opened up within parking bays on the east end of Marine Parade. This area will be safely enclosed with temporary fencing. The construction area will also include pipe reels and drilling equipment as part of the works.

To minimise the impact on traffic, the works will take place within the existing parking bays. Alternative parking is available nearby. Please see [Parking - Adur & Worthing Councils](#) for further information.

This is the first of two occasions on which we will need to visit this area. The second will take place towards the end of the planned construction programme.
